

Go thru that couple . . . And circle around that couple.

First couple again passes thru second couple, then first separate and go round and meet again in the center of the set.

And both couples swing . . . Circle four.

8. Explain and walk thru Chase the Rabbit. Be sure to tell the dancers that there are two different dances by this name. Do both of them.

CHASE THE RABBIT

First couple bow and swing, lead right to the right of the ring.

First couple goes to face the second couple.

Chase the rabbit, chase the squirrel, chase that pretty girl around the world.

The first lady goes between the second couple and then turns to her left to go around the second lady and returns to the center of the set . . . Now she again goes between the second couple but turns to her right to go around the second gent. Her partner has been following her all this time. Now he cuts in front of her and leads her thru the same figure.

Now chase the possum, chase the coon, chase that big boy round the room.

First gent cuts in front of first lady and leads between second couple and around second gent.. First lady follows first gent.

Now circle four.

CHASE THE RABBIT (Another version)

First couple bow and swing, now chase that pretty girl around the ring.

First gent chases his partner around the outside of the set, around to the right.

Chase that rabbit, chase that squirrel, chase that pretty girl round the world.

Now chase the possum, chase the coon, chase that big boy round the room.

First lady now chases her pard back around the ring to their home position.

Chase 'em up center for a two pair whirl.

First couple now crosses set to opposite couple. (The third couple.)

Each man swings the other man's girl.

Now swing your own and don't be late, everybody swing to your own back gate.

DOLLAR BILL

First couple bow and swing, lead right out to the right of the ring.

First couple goes to face second couple.

Swing two bits . . . Don't forget that four bits CHANGE.

First and second gents change partners and waist swing, change back and waist swing partners.

Swing six bits, if you will, don't forget that dollar bill.

First and second gents again exchange partners and waist swing.

You take back your dollar bill, give me back my whipperwill.

Circle Four.
