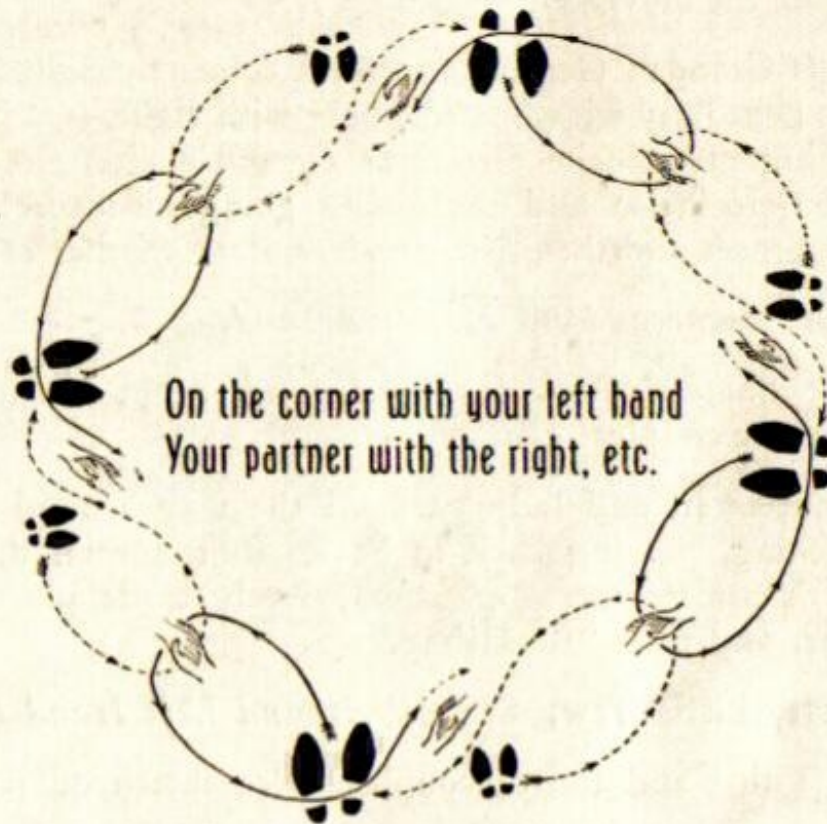


**Left Hand Cross:** See Right Hand Cross (may be called *Back with Left*).

**On the Corner with Your Left Hand:** Precedes *Right and Left Grand*. Left hand is given to corner, turn completely around and give right



hand to partner, then continue doing *Right and Left Grand*. (Study the hands in above sketch.)

**Once and a Half:** (Called while doing *Right and Left Grand*). On meeting partners, right arms are locked at the elbows and a complete turn is made, then each gentleman goes on to the next lady and with left arms locked turns completely, then to next, etc., until the partners again meet, then promenade unless another call is given.

**Opposite Swing:** Executed by the opposite gentleman and lady in the same manner as *Partner Swing*.

**Partner:** May be referred to as *Honey, Taw*, or many other pet names.

**Partner Swing:** Hands joined, arms extended, turn one time to left, swinging all the way around.

**Promenade:** Partners side by side, with right hands and left hands joined (like skating) circle to the left until they have reached home.

**Right and Left Eight:** Same as *Right and Left Grand*.
